
In checking with the Secretary of State's Office, we have been informed that you have failed to file the **amended** Receipts and Expenditures Report identified above as required by law. Such report, a blank copy of which is enclosed for your use, must be completed and filed within five (5) days from the date of receipt of this notice.

As provided by K.S.A. 25-4152, you have until **November 20, 2009**, which is 15 days from the date of this notice, to comply with the reporting requirements before a \$10 per day civil penalty is imposed for each day the required document remains unfiled. No civil penalty shall exceed three hundred dollars (\$300). Also, there are criminal penalties for intentionally failing to file. The intentional failure to file the required report within five (5) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures until the required report has been filed.

File the required report within five (5) days with the Secretary of State. As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the July 28, 2008 report lists two expenditures to the Sedgwick County Election Commissioner for filing fees, three expenditures to the Wichita Eagle for printing and reproduction, and two expenditures to Wooten Printing, Inc for printing and reproduction.

K.S.A 25-4148 (c) states... "In addition to the requirements of subsection (b), every treasurer for any political committee and party committee shall report the following:

(1)(A) The name and address of each candidate for state or local office for whom an expenditure in the form of an in-kind contribution has been made in an aggregate amount or having a fair market value in excess of \$300, with the amount, date and purpose of each. The report shall show in detail the specific service or product provided; and

(B) the name and address of each candidate for state or local office who is the subject of any expenditure which:

- (i) Is made without the cooperation or consent of a candidate or candidate committee;
- (ii) expressly advocates the nomination, election or defeat of such candidate; and
- (iii) is an aggregate amount or having a fair market value in excess of \$300."

An amended July 28, 2008 Receipts and Expenditures report must be filed to list the name and address of each candidate for whom the independent or in-kind expenditure in excess of \$300 was made.
