Alyssa,

Here is my note explaining about last years discrepencies.

On Oct 11, 2010 we had a fundraiser townhall meeting for Kris Kobach and Jana Goodman. We wrote a check to Kris for \$289. The check was never cashed. I included it on this years scedule A list so the allotted money could get back into our available funds with "check never cashed" in the occupation and industry lines as I was advised to do.

At the same fundraiser there was a \$20 donation given to him by members of our Republican group, Hank and Jan Koch. I believe this might have been reported as coming from the Leavenworth Central Committee. It did not come from us.

The second discrepancy that came up last year was a reporting by both Kris Kobach and Elizabeth Ensley of receiving \$100 cash from our committee. Our committee never gives donations in the form of cash so I believe it was given to them at the townhall meeting by an attendee and not knowing who had given it to them, they listed it as from the party.

The last discrepancy - a check for \$250.00 from the Connie O'Brien campaign - was given to us for the "watch party" after elections, written on Oct. 19th. It was not deposited by me until February. I was told that if it had been deposited before Dec 31, the report would need to be amended, but if deposited after Jan 1, to add it to this report. I don't think that I remembered to write anything about this check in the occupation/industry slot for this donation. There was also a check from the Owen Donohoe campaign in the amount of \$200.00 that was deposited at the same time.

Thank you for your help in clarifying these discrepencies.
