**NOTIFICATION OF FAILURE TO FILE
RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES REPORTS
AFTER EXCEEDING LIMITS**

A review of the files in the Secretary of State's Office indicates that you have failed to file Receipts and Expenditures Reports as required by law. Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4175, an affidavit of intent was previously filed indicating intent to expend or receive less than \$500 and receive less than \$50 per contributor. However, when either limit is exceeded, K.S.A. 25-4176 requires the treasurer of any party or political committee that has filed such an affidavit to file all past due reports within three days of exceeding either limit, and to file all future reports on the dates required by K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 25-4148. Blank reporting forms are enclosed for your use. *These reports must be completed and filed within 5 days from the date of receipt of this notice pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4148.*

Also as provided by K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 25-4152, you have until **April 18, 2013**, which is 15 days from the date of this notice, to comply with the reporting requirements before a \$10 per day civil penalty is imposed for each day the required reports remain unfiled. No civil penalty shall exceed three hundred dollars (\$300). Also, there are criminal penalties for intentionally failing to file. Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4167 the intentional failure to file the required reports is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures until the required reports have been filed.

As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office.
