The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for member of the house of representatives, . . . \$500 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Siegfried campaign reported receiving the following contributions during the general election cycle:

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted contributions in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$1250. We would suggest that these contributions be refunded immediately. The return of these contributions should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2010 Receipts and Expenditures Report.

2. The beginning balance of \$10,362.73 listed on the October 27, 2008 report is not the same as the ending balance of \$10,812.73 listed on the amended July 28, 2008 report that was filed on October 13, 2008. An amended cover summary page for the October 27, 2008 report must be filed with the correct totals.

3. The Campaign Finance Act requires that any contribution from an individual in excess of \$150 must be accompanied by the occupation and industry of the individual. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the October 27, 2008 report does not reflect **both** the occupation and industry of the individual donors. The report must be amended to show both the occupation and industry of all contributors who gave in excess of \$150.
