

K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for member of the house of representatives, . . . \$500 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Kuether campaign reported receiving a \$75 in-kind contribution on 10-24-08 from Carol McDowell and an-kind contribution in the amount of \$440.00 on 11-11-08, for a total of \$515. Both of these in-kind contributions were received during the general election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted an in-kind contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$15. We would suggest \$15 be refunded immediately. The return of this in-kind contribution should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2010 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
