

As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) indicates your campaign accepted the following cash contribution over \$100:

K.S.A. 25-4153(i) states, "No person shall make any contribution or contributions to any candidate or the candidate committee of any candidate in the form of money or currency of the United States which in the aggregate exceeds \$100 for any one primary or general election, and no candidate or candidate committee of any candidate shall accept any contribution or contributions in the form of money or currency of the United States which in the aggregate exceeds \$100 from any one person for any one primary or general election."

The cash contribution listed above should not have been accepted by the campaign. In the future, you must be certain that all contributions in excess of \$100 are made by check, cashier's check or money order.

2. Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions) of the July 28, 2008 Receipts and Expenditures Report lists three out-of-pocket expenditures the candidate made to the campaign totaling \$293.54. However, Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) lists the same expenditures. If payment was made through the campaign account, these entries should remain on Schedule C, not on Schedule B. If the candidate made these expenditures from personal funds, they should be listed on Schedule B, not Schedule C. An amended report must be filed with the expenditures on the correct schedule.

3. Schedule D (Other Transactions) of the July 28, 2008 report indicates a \$279.37 payable to the candidate for reimbursement for campaign letter to constituents. Any expenditures made from personal funds which are not deposited into a campaign bank account are to be reported on Schedule B as in-kind contributions from the donor in addition to being disclosed as a loan on Schedule D. An amended Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions) must be filed listing the in-kind contribution.
