RE: Amended January 10, 2009 Receipts and Expenditures Report

In checking with the Secretary of State and the candidate's County Clerk/County Election Office, we have been informed that you have failed to file the **amended** Receipts and Expenditures Report identified above as required by law. Such report, a blank copy of which is enclosed for your use, must be completed and filed within five (5) days from the date of receipt of this notice.

As provided by K.S.A. 25-4152, you shall have 15 days from the date of this notice (or until **October 7, 2009**) to comply with the reporting requirements before a civil penalty shall be imposed for each day the required document remains unfiled. The penalty shall be ten dollars (\$10) per day for each day the report remains unfiled, except that no civil penalty shall exceed three hundred dollars (\$300). Also, there are criminal penalties for intentionally failing to file. The intentional failure to file the required report within five (5) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures until the required report has been filed.

File the required report **within five (5) days** with the Secretary of State and your candidate's County Clerk/County Election Officer. As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your candidate's record in the Secretary of State's Office and your candidate's County Clerk/County Election Office.
