K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for member of the house of representatives, . . . \$500 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Norlin campaign reported receiving a \$400 in-kind contribution on 7-24-08 from Pamela Harris, and a \$200 in-kind contribution on 7-24-08, for a total of \$600. Both of these in-kind contributions were received during the primary election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted an in-kind contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$100. The campaign must reimburse Pamela Harris \$100 for her in-kind services to bring this in-kind contribution into compliance with the \$500 contribution limit. The reimbursement should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the October 27, 2008 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
