Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the October 25, 2010 Receipts & Expenditures Report lists \$1433.28 in expenditures, yet Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) lists \$1005.37 in contributions. This difference of \$427.91 must be explained in an amended report. If any expenditures were paid for personally by you or another contributor, they must be shown on Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions) as "in-kind" contributions from the donor to the campaign, not Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements). Expenditures should only be reported on Schedule C if they were paid from the campaign bank account.
