

In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. The beginning balance of \$24,800.63 listed on the October 25, 2010 report is not the same as the ending balance of \$24,300.63 listed on the July 26, 2010 amended report. An amended cover summary page for the October 25, 2010 report must be filed with the correct beginning balance.

2. According to the Candidate Last Minute Contribution Report filed by the Sheryl Spalding campaign on July 29, 2010, the campaign received a \$500 contribution on July 27, 2010 from Eli Lilly Co. This contribution was not reported by your campaign on the October 25, 2010 report. This contribution must **also** be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the October 25, 2010 report.

Please check your records to determine if the \$500 contribution was from Eli Lilly & Co. If so, pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153 the campaign accepted a contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$250 during the primary election period since the Spalding campaign reported receiving a \$250 contribution from Eli Lilly & Co on 9-10-09. We would suggest that this contribution be refunded immediately. The return of this contribution should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2012 report.
