

In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. The beginning balance of \$16,286.97 listed on the January 10, 2010 report is not the same as the ending balance of \$17,036.97 listed on the January 10, 2009 amended report. It appears the ending balance from the original January 10, 2009 report was used for the beginning balance on the January 10, 2010 report, not the ending balance from the amended January 10, 2009 report that was filed on October 14, 2009. An amended cover summary page for the January 10, 2010 report must be filed with the correct beginning balance.

2. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, the following PAC's report making contributions to the Paul Davis campaign:

These contributions were not reported by your campaign. If these contributions were received, they must be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the January 10, 2010 report. These errors will cause the cash balance on the front page summary sheet to be incorrect. Therefore, an amended front page summary sheet must also be filed. If the campaign did not receive these contributions, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.

3. The Campaign Finance Act requires that any contribution from an individual in excess of \$150 must be accompanied by the occupation and industry of the individual. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the report does not reflect both the occupation and industry of the individual donors. The report must be amended to show both the occupation and the industry of all contributors who gave in excess of \$150.
