

As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) must be amended to include the street or mailing addresses for all individuals and vendors to whom expenditures were made during the July 26, 2010 reporting period.

2. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the July 26, 2010 report lists a \$150 expenditure to Shirley Akers on 6-4-10 for "Office decor".

To be a permissible use of campaign funds, the expenditure must meet the criteria set forth in K.S.A. 25-4157a. Further explanation of this expenditure must be provided in a letter to the Commission.

3. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the July 26, 2010 report lists an expenditure to the KFL PAC for \$20 on 6-18-10.

On June 23, 1992, the Commission issued Opinion No. 92-24 concerning the permissible use of candidate campaign funds and ruled generally that such funds could not be given as donations to political committees. The opinion also stated that officeholders could purchase tickets to events at the lowest necessary price for the officeholder and his or her immediate family at fundraising and political events if the officeholder and his/her family attend the event.

If this expenditure was for the purchase of a ticket to a fundraising event rather than "donation" as shown on the report, that fact must be noted on an amended Schedule C. If this was a donation, the KFL PAC will be required to return your campaign funds or you will need to reimburse the campaign personally.
