K.S.A. 25-4153 (a) (1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for member of the house of representatives, . . . \$500 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Hicks campaign reported receiving a \$3039.92 in-kind contribution from Justin Copp for Food/Beverage during the general election period

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted an in-kind contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$2539.92. If the campaign can not reimburse the excess contribution of \$2539.92, the candidate must personally reimburse Justin Copp the excess in-kind contribution. We would suggest that the in-kind contribution be reimbursed immediately. A copy of the cancelled check must be provided to the Commission.
