**NOTIFICATION OF FAILURE TO FILE  
THE JULY 26, 2010 RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES REPORT**

In checking with the Secretary of State and the candidate's County Clerk/County Election office, we have been informed that you have failed to file the **July 26, 2010 Receipts and Expenditures Report** with both offices as required by law. Such report, a blank copy of which is enclosed for your use, must be completed and filed within five (5) days from the date of receipt of this notice.

As provided by K.S.A. 25-4152, you have until **August 12, 2010**, which is 15 days from the date of this notice, to comply with the reporting requirements before a \$10 per day civil penalty is imposed for each day the required document remains unfiled. No civil penalty shall exceed three hundred dollars (\$300). Also, there are criminal penalties for intentionally failing to file. The intentional failure to file the required report within five (5) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures until the required report has been filed.

File the required report within five (5) days with the Secretary of State and your candidate's County Clerk/County Election Officer. As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your candidate's record in the Secretary of State's Office and your candidate's County Clerk/County Election office.
