Dear Mr. Jones:

We have completed the review of the October 25, 2010 and the January 10, 2011 Receipts & Expenditures Reports you filed on behalf of the Philip Black for State Representative campaign.

During the review, we found a contribution of \$300 or more that was received from MAPCCS/KAPCCS on July 26, 2010. This contribution should have been shown on the Last Minute Contribution Report and filed with the Secretary of State and the candidate's home county election office on July 29, 2010. You were mailed the appropriate form, along with a cover letter explaining the requirement, on July 14, 2010.

In the future, you must be certain that any last minute contributions of \$300 or more are reported on the appropriate date. The failure to do so may result in a civil fine being assessed by the Governmental Ethics Commission.
