

In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the July 26, 2010 report lists an expenditure to the KFL PAC for \$500 on 7-22-10.

On June 23, 1992, the Commission issued Opinion No. 92-24 concerning the permissible use of candidate campaign funds and ruled generally that such funds could not be given as donations to political committees. The opinion also stated that officeholders could purchase tickets to events at the lowest necessary price for the officeholder and his or her immediate family at fundraising and political events if the officeholder and his/her family attend the event.

If this expenditure was for the purchase of a ticket to a fundraising event rather than "donation" as shown on the report, that fact must be noted on an amended Schedule C for the July 26, 2010 report. If this was a donation, the KFL PAC will be required to return your campaign funds or you will need to reimburse the campaign personally. The return of this contribution should be shown on Schedule C of the October 25, 2010 report.
