

As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Schedule D (Other Transactions) of the October 25, 2010 Receipts and Expenditures Report shows a loan from the candidate totaling \$1077.54 during this reporting period. All loans should also be listed on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) if the contribution was deposited into the campaign bank account or Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions) if expenditures were made by the candidate from personal funds. An amended report must be filed which includes this loan on Schedule A or Schedule B and the corresponding entry on the cover summary page.

2. Schedule D (Other Transactions) of the amended July 26, 2010 report lists loans totaling \$7540.72 and the October 25, 2010 report lists an additional loan for \$2040.00 to Dan Manning for a total of \$9580.72. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2011 report indicates \$481.23 was reimbursed to the candidate for loans, which leaves a loan balance of \$9099.49, and is not carried forward as a loan payable to the January 10, 2011 Receipts and Expenditures Report. All loans should be listed on Schedule D (Other Transactions) until such time as they are repaid or forgiven. An amended January 10, 2011 report must be filed disclosing the disposition of this debt.

3. Schedule D (Other Transactions) indicates your campaign accepted the following cash contribution over \$100:

K.S.A. 25-4153(i) states, "No person shall make any contribution or contributions to any candidate or the candidate committee of any candidate in the form of money or currency of the United States which in the aggregate exceeds \$100 for any one primary or general election, and no candidate or candidate committee of any candidate shall accept any contribution or contributions in the form of money or currency of the United States which in the aggregate exceeds \$100 from any one person for any one primary or general election."

The cash contribution listed above should not have been accepted by the campaign. In the future, you must be certain that all contributions in excess of \$100 are made by check, cashier's check or money order.
