

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

K.S.A. 25-4153a states that no registered lobbyist, political committee or person, other than an individual, shall make a contribution and no state officer or candidate for state officer elected on a statewide basis shall accept a contribution from a lobbyist, political committee or person, other than an individual after January 1 and prior to sine die adjournment (May 28, 2010) of the regular session of the legislature or any other time the legislature is in session. These contributions should not have been accepted and should be returned. The return of these contributions must be shown on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the October 25, 2010 report.

2. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the July 26, 2010 report indicates the candidate was reimbursed \$105 for the filing fee during this reporting period. The filing fee is also listed on Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions). Since the filing fee was repaid during the same reporting period, it should not be listed on Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions) or Line 6 of the cover summary page. An amended Schedule B and cover summary page must be filed correcting this error.
