1. K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for member of the house of representatives, . . . \$500 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Gregory campaign reported receiving the following contributions:

All of these contributions were received during the primary election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted contributions in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$1500. We would suggest that these contributions be refunded immediately. The return of these contributions should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the October 29, 2012 Receipts and Expenditures Report.

2. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the July 30, 2012 Receipts & Expenditures Report lists a \$250 contribution from Medco on 1-4-12 and a \$100 contribution from Glass House Liquor on 1-6-12. These contributions were previously reported on the January 10, 2012 report. An amended Schedule A must be filed removing these duplicate entries.

3. Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions) and Schedule D (Other Transactions) of the July 30, 2012 report lists \$5196.72 for expenditures the candidate made for the campaign during this reporting period. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the report indicates \$5196.72 was reimbursed to the candidate on 7-25-12 for the in-kind contributions. Since these in-kind contributions were reimbursed during the same reporting period, they should only be itemized on Schedule C. An amended Schedule B and Schedule D must be filed removing these entries. An amended cover summary page must also be filed with the correct totals.

4. Schedule D (Other Transactions) of the January 10, 2012 lists a \$12,896.27 loan payable to the candidate. This loan is not carried forward as a loan payable to the July 30, 2012 Receipts and Expenditures Report, nor is it disclosed on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements). All loans payable should be listed on Schedule D (Other Transactions) until such time as they are repaid or forgiven. An amended July 30, 2012 report must be filed disclosing the disposition of this debt.
