1. The cover summary page for the July 30, 2012 report contains a \$999.91 subtraction error. The cash on hand at close of period should be \$15462.01, not \$14462.10 as indicated. An amended cover summary page must be filed with the correct total.

2. K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for member of the house of representatives, . . . \$500 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The LeDoux campaign reported receiving a \$500 contribution on 10-15-11 from the Kansas Health Care Association PAC and an additional \$200 on 7-17-12, for a total of \$700. Both of these contributions were received during the primary election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted a contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$200. We would suggest that this contribution be refunded immediately. The return of this contribution should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the October 29, 2012 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
