Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the July 30, 2012 report shows an \$1800 loan from the candidate. All loans should also be listed on Schedule D (Other Transactions) until such time as they are repaid or forgiven. An amended report must be filed which includes Schedule D and the corresponding entry on Line 7 of the cover summary page.

2. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the July 30, 2012 report lists a \$100 donation to the Republican House Campaign Committee on 1-9-12. K.S.A. 25-4153a states that no registered lobbyist, political committee or person, other than an individual, shall make a contribution and no legislator or candidate for the legislature shall accept a contribution from a lobbyist, political committee or person, other than an individual after January 1 and prior to sine die adjournment of the regular session of the legislature or any other time the legislature is in session. This campaign donation to the recognized political party committee should not have been given. It will be necessary for the Garber campaign to contact the Republican House Campaign Committee for a refund. The return of this donation must be shown on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the October 29, 2012 report.
