Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

K.S.A. 25-4154 (b) states, “No person shall give or accept any contribution in excess of \$10 unless the name and address of the contributor is known to the individual receiving the contribution.” An explanation of this contribution must be provided. If the campaign is not aware of the name of the contributor of this contribution, \$20 must be expended in a non-political manner since this would be an illegal contribution.
