Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the October 29, 2012 report lists two \$20 contributions with the notation "Anonymous". Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) indicates one of the \$20 anonymous contributions was given to the NOMAH Community Development Corporation.

K.S.A. 25-4154 (b) states, "No person shall give or accept any contribution in excess of \$10 unless the name and address of the contributor is known to the individual receiving the contribution." An explanation of the other \$20 anonymous contribution must be provided. If the campaign is not aware of the name of the contributor of the contribution, \$20 must be expended in a non-political manner since this would be an illegal contribution. An explanation of this contribution must be provided in a letter to the Commission.
