

As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, Kansas Chamber Jobs PAC reports making a \$78 in-contribution to Brian Weber on 12-26-11 for a voter file. This in-kind contribution was not reported by your campaign. If this in-kind contribution was received, it must be reported on Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions) on the January 10, 2012 report. An amended front page summary sheet must also be filed. If the campaign did not receive this in-kind contribution, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.

2. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) indicates \$75 was received from unknown contributors on 7/29/11.

K.S.A. 25-4154 (b) states, "No person shall give or accept any contribution in excess of \$10 unless the name and address of the contributor is known to the individual receiving the contribution." An explanation of the \$75 contribution must be provided. If the campaign is not aware of the names of the contributors, \$75 must be expended in a non-political manner since these would be illegal contributions. An explanation of these contributions must be provided in a letter to the Commission.

3. In reviewing the January 10, 2012 Receipts and Expenditures Report, we find that Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) does not contain street or mailing addresses for 7 individuals who contributed \$100. Schedule A must be amended to include street or mailing addresses for these individuals.
