Schedule D (Other Transactions) of the January 10, 2017 Receipts and Expenditures Report filed by the Jerry Stogsdill campaign lists a loan payable totaling \$1925.46 to Tucker Poling on 7-26-16. Neither the October 31, 2016, nor the January 10, 2017 Receipts and Expenditures Reports reflect any reimbursement for this loan. K.S.A. 25-4153(b) states "... the face value of a loan at the end of the period of time allocable to the primary or general election is the amount subject to the limitations of this section. A loan in excess of the limits herein provided may be made during the allocable period if such loan is reduced to the permissible level, when combined with all other contributions from the person making such loan, at the end of such allocable period. The campaign must reimburse Tucker Poling \$1425.46 to be within the \$500 contribution limitation for a House of Representative campaign. The return of this loan will need to be reported on the January 10, 2018 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
