1. The beginning balance of \$2552.01 on the January 10, 2021 report is not the same as the ending balance on the October 26, 2020 report. An amended front page summary sheet for the January 10, 2021 report must be filed with the correct beginning balance.
2. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2021 report lists a \$362.50 expenditure to the Salina Journal on 9-10-20. This expenditure was previously reported on the October 26, 2020 report. An amended Schedule C must be filed removing this duplicate entry.
