As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the July 25, 2022 report shows a \$1,000.00 loan from Bill Hutton. **All loans should also be listed on Schedule D (Other Transactions) until such time as they are repaid or forgiven.** An amended report must be filed which includes Schedule D and the corresponding entry on Line 7 of the cover summary page.
2. The July 25, 2022 report did not disclose a payment to the Secretary of State for the candidate's filing fee. If the filing fee was paid by the candidate from personal funds, it should be recorded on Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions) as an "in-kind" contribution from the candidate to the campaign. If the filing fee was paid from campaign funds, this expenditure should be listed on Schedule C (Expenditures & Other Disbursements). The July 25, 2022 report must be amended by showing the payment of the filing fee either on Schedule B or Schedule C and on the cover summary page.
3. K.A.R. 19-29-3(a)(4) states that illegibility of a receipts and expenditures report is a material error or omission in a report. K.S.A. 25-4148 (e) further states that the Commission may require any treasurer to file an amended report for any period for which the original report filed by such treasurer contains material errors or omissions.

The July 25, 2022 Receipts & Expenditures Report filed by the Bill Hutton for State Representative campaign is illegible. An amended report must be filed which is readable.
