- 1. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the January 10, 2022 report lists a \$500 contribution on 12-21-20 with "Business Owner" as the name of the contributor. An amended Schedule A must be filed with the name of the donor.
- 2. Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions) of the January 10, 2022 report lists two reimbursements on 12-1-21 from Arnberger for Kansas for \$216.00 and \$500 from ALEC. If these were monetary reimbursements that were deposited into the campaign bank account, they must be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) and removed from Schedule B. If these reimbursements have not been paid and are campaign account receivables, they must be reported on Schedule D (Other Transactions), not Schedule B.
- 3. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2022 report lists two expenditures to "Ellis County Abstract refund of AMEX charge" on 8-30-21 in the amount of \$968.05 for "Meeting/Travel ALEC Hotel" and \$260.00 on 10-01-21 for "Fundraising Expenses Parade Candy 10/22/21". An amended Schedule C must be filed with the correct name of the vendor for these two expenditures.
