

**Notification of Material Error or Omission  
In A Receipts and Expenditure Report**

As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, the Kansas National Education Association PAC reports giving a \$331.50 rebate on 2/20/2007 to the UniServ Southeast Teachers PAC. This rebate was not reported by your committee. If this rebate was received, it must be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the January 10, 2008 report. If the committee did not receive this rebate please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.
2. The cover page of the January 10, 2008 Receipts and Expenditures Report lists \$35.00 on line 2 (Total Contributions and Other Receipts). According to Schedule A, the \$35.00 was a check to the Governmental Ethics Commission for the registration fee. Only money received by the committee goes on Schedule A. The \$35.00 needs to be removed from Schedule A and reported on Schedule C (Total Expenditures and Other Disbursements) as it was an expense paid for by the committee.
