

Notification of Material Error or Omission
In A Receipts and Expenditure Report

RE: Receipts and Expenditures Report due January 10, 2008
(Covering the Period January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007)

A review of your Receipts and Expenditures report identified above indicates the material errors or omissions listed on the other side of this page. Such errors and omissions must be corrected within (30) days of the date of this notice by filing an amended report.

File the amended report within thirty (30) days with:

As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Schedule A (Contributions and other Receipts) lists a \$75.00 anonymous contribution received on 9/27/2007.

K.S.A. 25-4154(b) states “ No person shall give or accept any contribution in excess on \$10 unless the name and address of the contributor is known to the individual receiving the contribution.” If the committee is not aware of the name of the contributor of the \$75.00 the committee accepted an illegal contribution. We would suggest that the \$75.00 be donated to a non political organization (i.e., a charity) within 30 days. A copy of the check making that donation and the address of the recipient should be noted in a letter to the Commission. The disbursement of the \$75.00 should then be reported on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the July 28, 2008 report. If the committee does know the identity of these contributions, a letter stating that fact should be submitted to the Commission

2. Page two of Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) list several contributions without the street or mailing address. Schedule A must be amended to include the street or mailing addresses for all Contributors who gave money to the committee during the reporting period.

3. Schedule A (Contributions and other Receipts) lists several contributions over \$150 where the occupation of the contributor is left blank.

K.S.A. 25-4148a states “ When a report is made under this act and the amount being contributed by an individual is over \$150, the report shall list the occupation of the individual contributor, or if the individual contributor is not employed for compensation then the report shall list the occupation of the contributor’s spouse...”

An amended January 10, 2008 report must be filed to list the occupation of individual contributors who made donations over \$150.00.

4. The January 10, 2008 cover page has a calculation error in the ending balance. The correct ending balance should be \$-785.87 not \$586.88 as reported. An amended January 10, 2008 summary page must be filed to show the corrected ending balance.
