As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

The information contained in the Annual Income and Expenses report you submitted with the Secretary of State must be resubmitted in the proper format for a Receipts and Expenditures Report.

1. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) must be completed to show the name and address of the contributor and the amount received from each contributor. If the contribution is over \$150 and from an individual, the occupation and industry of each individual must also be reported.
2. The computer printout used for Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) does not contain a column indicating whether the contribution is in the form of cash, check, loan or other. An amended **January 10, 2009** report must be filed to reflect whether the contribution received was made by check, cash, loan or other
3. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) must be completed to include the street or mailing addresses for all individuals and vendors to whom expenditures were made. This should include the expenditure made to ASA Marketing, as well as the fact this expenditure was an independent expenditure, along with the name of the candidate whose election was advocated.
4. Only contributions received and expenditures made during the reporting period of October 24, 2008 through December 31, 2008 should be reported on the January 10, 2009 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
