
File the amended report within thirty (30) days with:

As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) must be amended to include the street or mailing addresses for all individuals and vendors to whom expenditures in excess of \$50 were made during the reporting period.
2. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) must be amended to include the "Purpose of Expenditure" (i.e., contribution, ads, stamps, salary, etc.) for all expenditures made in excess of \$50.
3. Schedule D (Other Transactions) lists two entries that appear to be expenditures made during the reporting period. If the two entries were made using PAC funds, they should have been reported on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) not on Schedule D. If the two entries were paid for by someone else and not the PAC fund, they should have also been listed on Schedule B as an in-kind contribution. The name and address of the person or group giving the in-kind must also be listed on Schedule B.

An amended **October 27, 2008** report must be filed showing these entries on the appropriate schedule.
