
File the amended report within thirty (30) days with:

As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) must be amended to include the street or mailing addresses for all individuals and vendors to whom expenditures in excess of \$50 were made during the reporting period.

2. A review of the October 25, 2010 Receipts and Expenditures Report indicates the Kansas Black Republican Council made a \$100 contribution to Lynn Jenkins, candidate for Congress.

K.S.A. 25-4153 (f) states, “Any political funds which have been collected and were subject to the reporting requirements of the campaign finance act shall not be used in or for the campaign of a candidate for a federal elective office.”

Since the Act specifically states that a political committee may not make such a contribution, the committee must obtain a refund of these contributions immediately. **The refund will then be shown on Schedule A (Contributions & Other Receipts) of the report filed by the committee for the time period in which the refund is received.** A copy of the letter requesting the refund should be submitted to the Commission.
