The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Richard Guinn reports giving a \$2,500.00 contribution to the Kansas Democratic Party on 9/4/2008. According to Schedule A of the October 27, 2008 report, the Kansas Democratic Party reports receiving \$1,600.00 on 9/10/2008, a difference of \$900.00. This difference must be explained in a letter to the Commission or on an amended October 27, 2008 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
2. Melanie Meier reports receiving an in-kind contribution from the Kansas Democratic Party in the amount of \$12,686.00 on 10/23/2008 for direct mail. According to Schedule C of the October 27, 2008 report, the Kansas Democratic Party reports giving \$10,054.14, a difference of \$2,631.86. This difference must be explained in a letter to the Commission or on an amended October 27, 2008 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
3. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, Steven Lukert reports receiving a \$500.00 contribution from the Kansas Democratic Party on 10/20/2008. This contribution was not reported as being given by your committee. If this contribution was given, it must be reported on **Schedule C** (Total Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the October 27, 2008 report. If the committee did not give this contribution please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.
