

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, the Kansas Committee for Rural Electrification PAC reports making a \$300 contribution to Dennis McKinney on 7-13-10. This contribution was not reported by your campaign. If this contribution was received, it must be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the October 25, 2010 report. This error will cause the cash balance on the front page summary sheet to be incorrect. Therefore, an amended front page summary sheet must also be filed. If the campaign did not receive this contribution, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.

2. K.S.A. 25-4148 (b) (7) requires that when an expenditure is made by payment to an advertising agency, public relations firm or political consultants for disbursement to vendors, the report of such expenditure shall show in detail the name of each such vendor and the amount, date and purpose of the payment to each. An expenditure amounting to \$6523.20 was made to the Kansas Press Association on 10-15-10 for "Newspaper Ads" and expenditures totaling \$203,669.57.00 were made to Buying Time Media for "Radio/TV". Please submit the required supplemental information as an amendment to Schedule C on the October 25, 2010 Receipts and Expenditures Report.


We have completed the review of the October 25, 2010 and the January 10, 2011 Receipts & Expenditures Reports you filed on behalf of the Dennis McKinney for Secretary of State campaign.

During the review, we found a contribution of \$300 or more that was received from the Kansas State Firefighters PAC on October 27, 2010. This contribution should have been shown on the Last Minute Contribution Report and filed with the Secretary of State on October 28, 2010. You were mailed a memo explaining the requirement on October 12, 2010.

In the future, you must be certain that any last minute contributions of \$300 or more are reported on the appropriate date. The failure to do so may result in a civil fine being assessed by the Governmental Ethics Commission.
