
In checking with the Secretary of State, we have been informed that your campaign has failed to electronically file the **amended** Receipts and Expenditures Report identified above as required by law.

As provided by K.S.A. 25-4152, you shall have 15 days from the date of this notice (or until **June 1, 2011**) to comply with the reporting requirements before a civil penalty shall be imposed for each day the required document remains unfiled. The penalty shall be ten dollars (\$10) per day for each day the report remains unfiled, except that no civil penalty shall exceed three hundred dollars (\$300). Also, there are criminal penalties for intentionally failing to file. The intentional failure to file the required report within five (5) days is a class A misdemeanor.

File the required report **within five (5) days** with the Secretary of State. As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office.


In checking with the Secretary of State's Office, we have been informed that you have failed to electronically file the **amended** Receipts and Expenditures Report identified above as required by law.

As provided by K.S.A. 25-4152, you shall have 15 days from the date of this notice (or until **June 1, 2011**) to comply with the reporting requirements before a civil penalty shall be imposed for each day the required document remains unfiled. The penalty shall be ten dollars (\$10) per day for each day the report remains unfiled, except that no civil penalty shall exceed three hundred dollars (\$300). Also, there are criminal penalties for intentionally failing to file. The intentional failure to file the required report within five (5) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures until the required report has been filed.

File the required report **within five (5) days** with the Secretary of State. As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your candidate's record in the Secretary of State's Office.
