This communication is an attempt to collect a debt and any information obtained will be used for that purpose.


On June 25, 2015, administrative orders issued by the Kansas Governmental Ethics Commission (Commission) were mailed to you at the above address by certified mail, signed return receipt requested. They were resent to you October 12, 2015 by first class mail. The orders assess a total of \$600 in civil penalties for failure to timely file the February 23 and March 30, 2015, Receipts and Expenditures Reports.

A letter dated September 4, 2015, from Executive Director Carol Williams was mailed to you to remind you to pay the civil penalties. However, as of the date of this letter, the Commission has not received payment.

Please be advised that the Commission takes failure to pay assessed civil penalties seriously. In the absence of payment **in full by January 15, 2016**, the Commission intends to exercise any legal remedies available—including the State of Kansas Debt Setoff program. If the Commission refers your debt to this program, the Kansas Department of Revenue will divert \$600 to the Commission from any money due you from the State of Kansas. Additionally, if you fail to pay by that date, your name will be posted prominently on the Commission's website for failure to meet this financial responsibility.

Further action to collect the civil penalty may be avoided by mailing a check or money order in the amount of **\$600.00** made payable to the Governmental Ethics Commission so that receipt occurs **by January 15, 2016**.
