Dear Mr. Phalp:

This communication is an attempt to collect a debt and any information obtained will be used for that purpose.

On March 19, 2015, an administrative order issued by the Kansas Governmental Ethics Commission (Commission) was mailed to you at the above address by certified mail, signed return receipt requested. A \$60 civil penalty were assessed for failure to timely file an Employment and Expenditures Reports. A signed certified mail return receipt was returned indicating delivery was accepted on March 21, 2015.

A letter dated May 27, 2015, Executive Director Carol Williams was mailed to you as a reminder to pay the civil penalty. As of this date the Commission has not received your payment.

Please be advised that the Commission takes failure to pay assessed civil penalties quite seriously. In the absence of payment **in full by July 30, 2015**, the Commission intends to exercise any legal remedies available - including the State of Kansas Debt Setoff program. If the Commission refers your debt to this program, the Kansas Department of Revenue will divert \$60 to the Commission from any funds that the State of Kansas my owe you, including tax refunds. Additionally, if you fail to pay the civil penalty by that date, your name will be posted prominently on the Commission's website for failure to meet this financial responsibility

In the alternative, you may send a money order (a check is no longer acceptable due to your prior NSF payment noted above) in the amount of \$60.00 made payable to the Governmental Ethics Commission by July 30, 2015.
