Dear Mr. Rickel:

This communication is an attempt to collect a debt and any information obtained will be used for that purpose.


On September 18, 2014, an administrative order issued by the Kansas Governmental Ethics Commission (Commission) was mailed to you at the above address by certified mail, signed return receipt requested. A total of \$300 in civil penalties were assessed for failure to timely file a required report. This mailing was returned unclaimed.

The administrative order was mailed to you by first class mail on February 4, 2015, and has not been returned undeliverable. A cover letter from Executive Director Carol Williams informing you of your need to pay the civil penalty was included. As of the date of this letter the Commission has not received your payment.

Please be advised that the Commission takes failure to pay assessed civil penalties quite seriously. In the absence of payment **in full by March 20, 2015**, the Commission intends to exercise any legal remedies available - including the State of Kansas Debt Setoff program. If the Commission refers your debt to this program, the Kansas Department of Revenue will divert \$300 to the Commission from any funds that the State of Kansas may owe you, including tax refunds. Additionally, if you fail to pay the civil penalty by that date, your name will be posted prominently on the Commission's website for failure to meet this financial responsibility.

In the alternative, you may send a money order (a check is no longer acceptable due to your prior NSF payment noted above) in the amount of **\$300.00** made payable to the Governmental Ethics Commission **by March 20, 2015**.
