This communication is an attempt to collect a debt and any information obtained will be used for that purpose.

On March 19, 2008, the Governmental Ethics Commission assessed a civil penalty against you in the amount of \$300.00 for the late filing of the January 10, 2008 Receipts and Expenditures Report as required by K.S.A. 25-4148. If I do not receive payment or hear from you, I may proceed with a court action against you to enforce the Commission's civil penalty.
