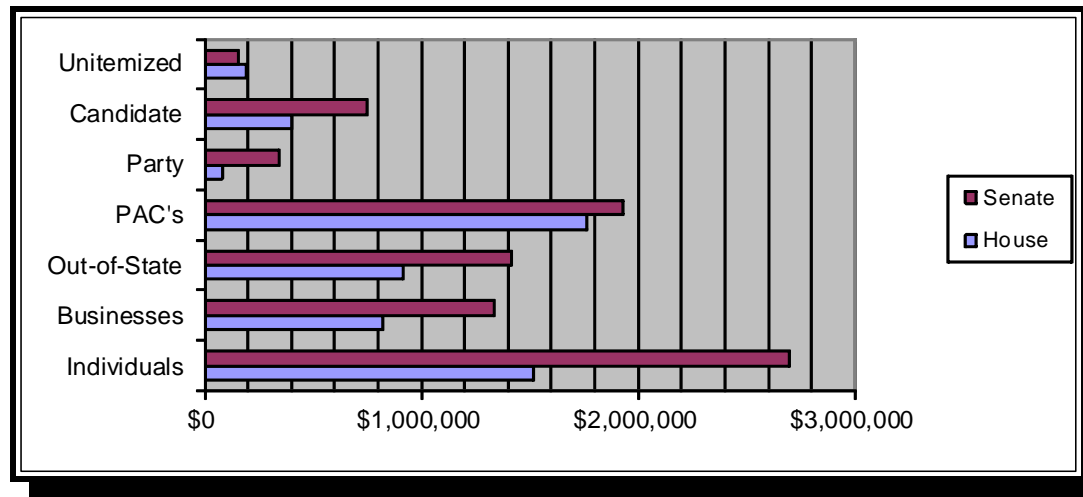

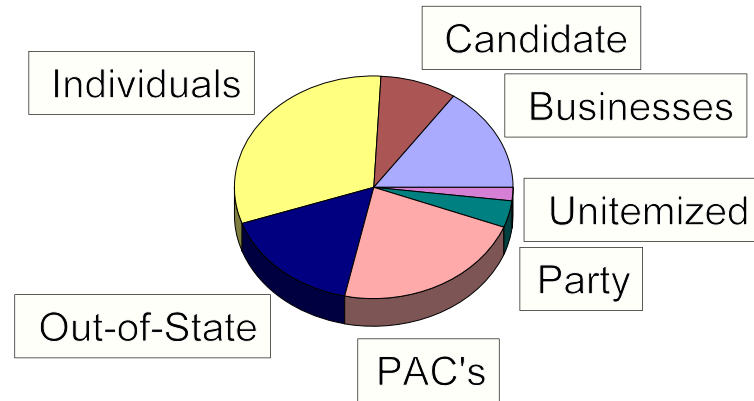

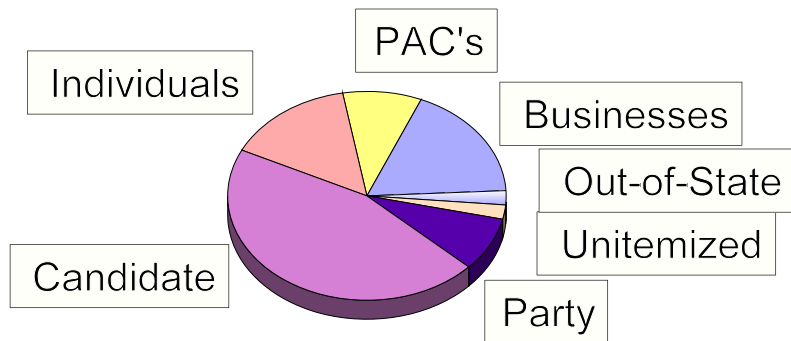

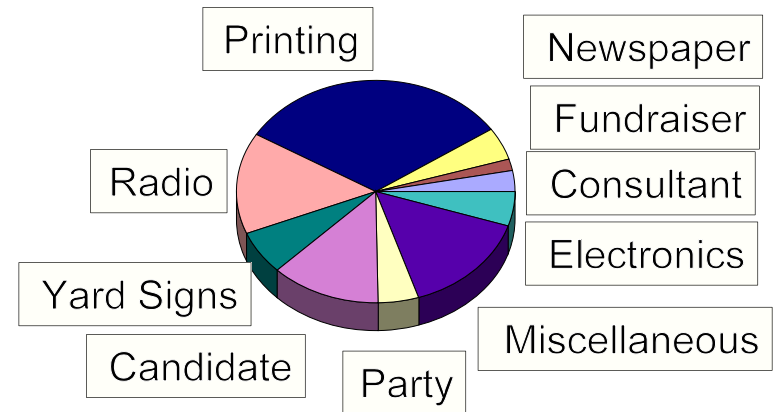

20 YEAR COMPARISON OF SENATE MONETARY CONTRIBUTIONS



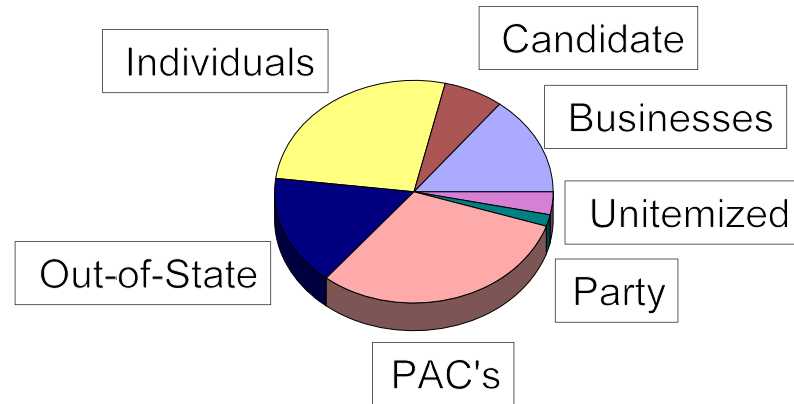

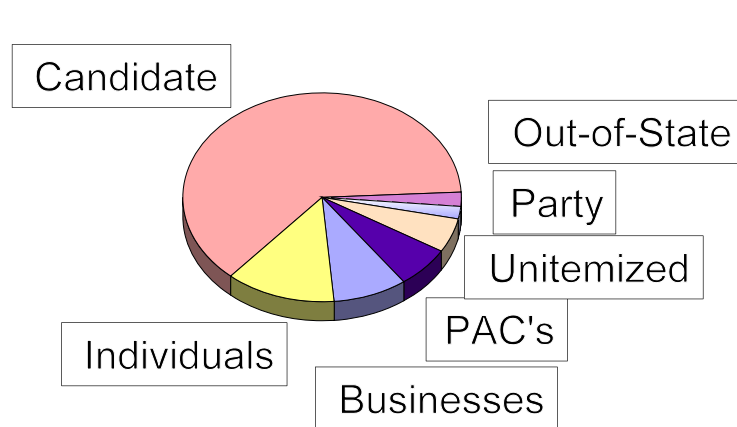

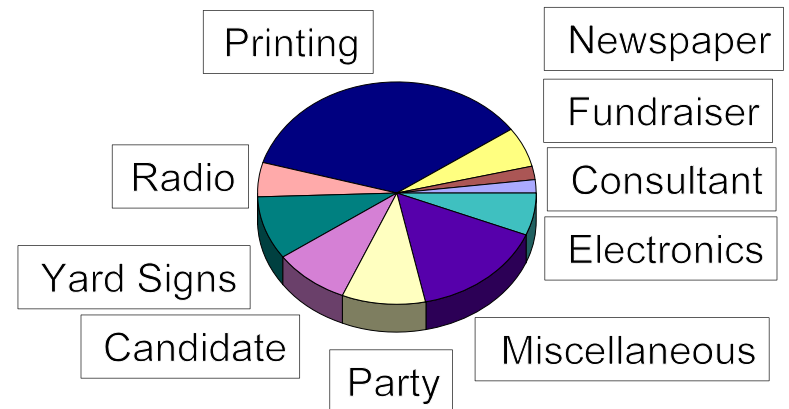
Monetary Contributions

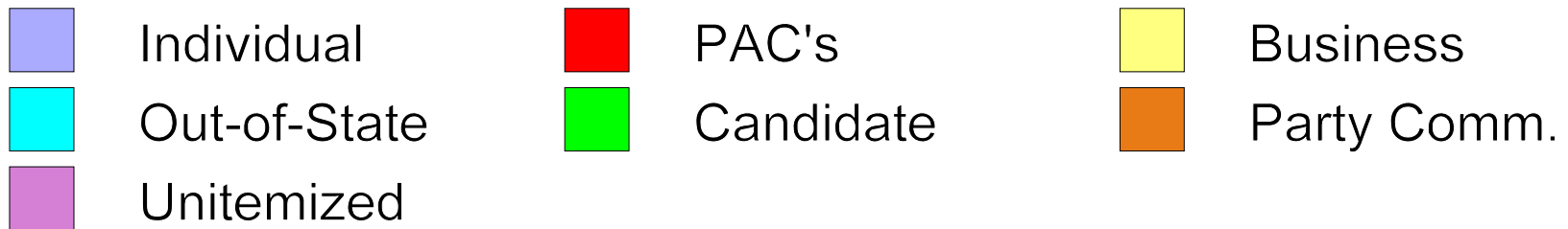
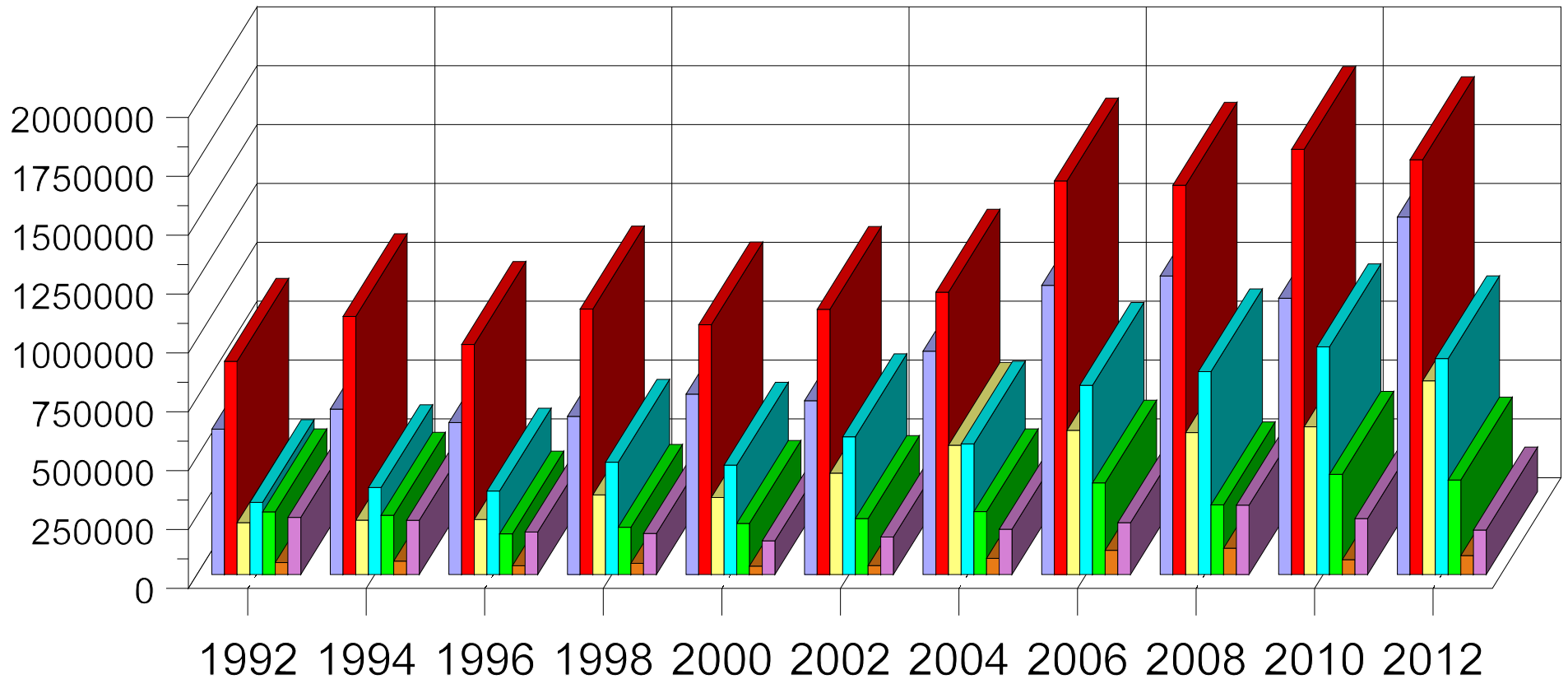
