Notification of Failure to File the March 10, 2013 Lobbyist Employment and Expenditure Report

According to the Secretary of State's Office, you have failed to file the Lobbyist Employment and Expenditure Report due March 10, 2013 (covering the period February 2013) as required by K.S.A. 46-268. Such report, a blank copy of which is enclosed for your use, must be completed and filed within five (5) days of the date of receipt of this notice, or a civil penalty shall be imposed for each day the required report remains unfiled.

As provided by K.S.A. 46-280, you have 5 days from receiving this notice to comply with the reporting requirements before a ten dollar (\$10) per day civil penalty is imposed for each day the required report remains unfiled. No civil penalty shall exceed three hundred (\$300). Also, there are criminal penalties for intentionally failing to file. It is unlawful to lobby when a current report has not been filed or is past due. Unlawful lobbying is a class B misdemeanor.
