This communication is an attempt to collect a debt and any information obtained will be used for that purpose.


Carol Williams, Executive Director, wrote to you on December 8, 2011 and again on March 13, 2012, regarding a \$300 civil penalty that was assessed against you by the Governmental Ethic Commission for failure to timely file your Statement of Substantial Interests.

To date, the Commission has not received payment from you to cover this civil penalty.

Please be advised that the Commission takes failure to pay assessed civil penalties quite seriously. In the absence of payment **in full by July 15, 2012**, the Commission intends to exercise any legal remedies available - including the State of Kansas Debt Setoff program. If the Commission refers your debt to this program, the Kansas Department of Revenue will divert \$300 to the Commission from any State of Kansas refund due you for tax year 2012 and subsequent years. Additionally, if you fail to pay the civil penalty by that date, your name will be posted prominently on the Commission's website for failure to meet this financial responsibility.

In the alternative, you may send a check or money order in the amount of **\$300.00** made payable to the Governmental Ethics Commission **by July 15, 2012**
