Carol Williams, Executive Director, wrote to you on May 25, 2011, regarding a \$300 civil penalty that was assessed against you, as candidate for state representative, by the Governmental Ethics Commission for failure to file your January 10, 2011 Receipts and Expenditures Report in a timely manner.


As you should be aware, the civil penalty was assessed because you failed to file your January 10, 2011 Receipts and Expenditures Report in a timely manner.

To date, the Commission has not received payment from you to cover these civil penalties.

Please be advised that the Commission takes failure to pay assessed civil penalties quite seriously. In the absence of payment **in full by November 30, 2011**, the Commission intends to exercise any legal remedies available - including the State of Kansas Debt Setoff program. If the Commission refers your debt to this program, the Kansas Department of Revenue will divert \$300 to the Commission from any State of Kansas refund due you for tax year 2011. Additionally, if you fail to pay the civil penalty by that date, your name will be posted prominently on the Commission's website for failure to meet this financial responsibility.

In the alternative, you may send a check or money order in the amount of **\$300.00** made payable to the Governmental Ethics Commission **by November 30, 2011**.
