Re: Civil Penalty Assessment

Dear Mr. Watson:

**This communication is an attempt to collect a debt and any information obtained will be used for that purpose.**

On April 15, 2009, the Governmental Ethics Commission reviewed your request for a waiver of the \$120.00 civil penalty assessed against you for your late filing of your October 27, 2008 Receipts and Expenditures Report. The Commission took no action to waive the penalty against you. A copy of the Civil Assessment Penalty Order, which was sent to you on December 17, 2008, by certified mail, is enclosed. Due to your failure to respond to the Commission's repeated requests for payment, said assessment has been referred to me for collection.

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with a final opportunity to pay the assessment against you prior to my filing a suit for collection of the amount.

If you wish to resolve this matter prior to a lawsuit being filed, please send a check in the amount of \$120.00 payable to the State of Kansas to me at the above address within thirty days of the date of this letter, or contact me within the same time period to make arrangements for regular payments to be made to pay this debt.

If I do not receive payment or hear from you, I may proceed with a court action or a state debt collection action against you to enforce the Commission's civil penalty.
